

30 people were lucky enough to tour the Chain Forge building for a pre-construction tour for FCNY's observation of May's historic preservation month. Thank you to the CV Properties Project Manager Yvette Tetreault for the look ahead to what is planned and to Boston's National Historical Park employees David Vecchioli and David Flanagan for coordinating and sharing historic information about the building.

During the tour we learned that the excess equipment will be auctioned and there will be pieces in the lobby area of the hotel. Some overhead cranes will also remain. Demlition/construction will commence once the equipment is removed.
